The secretariat of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption presents its compliments to the [[[AddressLine1]]] [[[ToUNOV]]] and has the honour to refer to note verbale CU 2022/299/DTA/CEB/TSS of 7 September 2022, in which the Government was requested to provide information to the secretariat regarding good practices, practical examples and lessons learned from engaging the private sector and using sanctions and incentives to strengthen business integrity in the last decade.

With reference to the note verbale, the secretariat would like to reiterate the request to submit relevant information.
